4 Hearing from God. Prayer is not only talking to God but listening to Him as well. As you pray open your bible and listen for the voice of God. -Psalm 143:8; Whether I turn to the right or to the left, may I hear your voice, saying, "This is the way; walk in it." Isaiah 30:21 NIV

7 Lift up a prayer for families, marriages, and relationships for spiritual growth and fruit. -Psalm 128:1-3 / Let us protect and trust one another; fill our hearts with hope and equip us to endure. 1 Corinthians 13:7 NIV / Show me how to pour out my heart in your presence, lifting up my hands to you for the lives of my children. 8 Prayer for church unity, growth, and for the building up of the body of Christ. Ephesians 4:12-13

9 Set your mind on things above. Pray for the ministry at CHMBC- that the Pastor, Staff, Ministry Leaders, Volunteers, Deacons and Trustees would serve with an eternal perspective. Colossians 3:1-2

10 Pray for our congregation - that we would passionately pursue the will of the Lord in all we say and do. Colossians 3:17

11 Time / Asking God for opportunities. Pray for open doors to share the gospel. Colossians 4:3 / Teach me to number my days and spend them as I should. Psalm 90:12 TLB
